- (b) notice in accordance with Article 16(2)(a), or
- (c) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 16(4),

whichever such date is the later.

The application and associated correspondence, including the acknowledgements and notifications referred to in Article 15, are available on the public file relating to the application as they arise and that file may be inspected by any person during office hours at the Agency's headquarters. A copy of the file is also available for inspection at the offices of Waterford City Council. Copy extracts from the file will be supplied by the Agency to any person, on request, subject to payment of the reasonable cost of making the copy.

The Agency will have regard to any submission made in accordance with the Regulations and will write, in due course, to each person who makes such a submission, to advise them of the Agency's proposed decision on the review.

In accordance with Article  $24(1)(b) \setminus 22(1)(b)$  of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations,  $2000 \setminus 2004$ , the Agency will write to you to inform you of its proposed decision on the review in due course.
