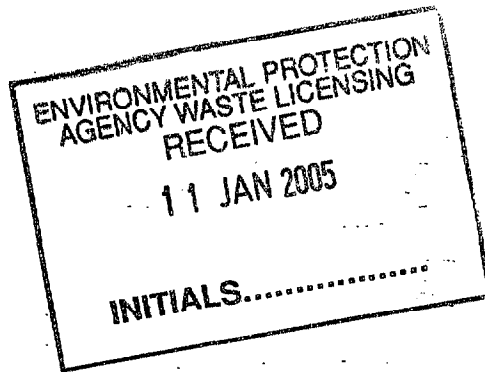

re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. McNamara,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Gleneden Trading Ltd, Unit 9, Raffeen Industrial Estate, Raffeen. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 7 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice as erected or fixed on the facility or premises contravene Article 7(1)(b) of the regulations.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

1. Ensure a site notice is erected or fixed on the facility pursuant to article 5 and is securely erected or fixed in a conspicuous position on or near the main entrance to the facility from a public road.
2. The site notice erected or fixed pursuant to article 5 shall be maintained in position where erected or fixed for at least two months and shall be renewed or replaced if it is removed or becomes defaced or illegible within the period during which it is required to be displayed.


The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

1. A letter stating the date on which the location of the site notice was amended.
2. A drawing showing its new location.

The evidence requested should be submitted within 10 working days of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus three copies. In addition submit one copy on a CD-ROM to the Agency. The e-file should be saved as a 'pdf' file, read only status.
