Attachment J.1 Accident Prevention & Emergency Response

The on-site potential for unauthorised or unexpected releases to the environment is considered to be confined to incidents such as a fire. KTS will prepare an Emergency Response Procedure which will be forwarded to the Agency for approval before operations begin. The Procedure will include emergency contact numbers. The procedure will ensure a rapid response to any incident by trained staff and minimise the impact on the environment of any associated emissions.

The cut-off valve provided on the surface water and sewer drainage systems in conjunction with the perimeter kerb will provide a retention capacity for firewater run-off in the unlikely event of a fire at the facility.

The proposed environmental monitoring programme will allow an assessment of the impact of any unexpected emissions that may arise from the site, but this programme can be expanded as required in the event of an incident.
