Bord na Móna Environmental Limited have been commissioned by Oxigen Environmental Ltd., to undertake a revision of the existing waste licence and subsequent Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), for their bailing station at Robinhood Industrial Estate, Ballymount, Clondalkin, Dublin 22.

Oxigen Environmental Ltd. currently operates a bailing station at the facility, which is operated in accordance with a waste licence (Reg. No. 152-1). This facility currently accepts 24,600 tonnes of waste, which consists of commercial, industrial, household and construction and demolition. It is proposed under this revision to increase the volume accepted to 160,000 tonnes of household waste only. Waste shall be accepted on site, inspected and then bailed for final disposal. The bailing station operations will be designed to meet the Environmental Protection Agency's 'BAT Guidance Notes for the Waste Sector: Treatment Activities' (Draft, November 2003).

Under Part 2 of Schedule 5 of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 'Installation for the disposal of waste with an annual intake greater than 25,000 tonnes...' requires the completion of an Environmental Impact Statement. In preparation of the EIS, due regard will be paid to the 'Advice Notes on Current Practice in the preparation of Environmental Impact Statements' and 'Guidelines on the Information to be Contained in Environmental Impact Statements (March 2002)' issued by the Environmental Protection Agency and the requirements of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001 (S.I. No. 600 of 2001).

Bord na Móna Environmental Limited would, therefore, be grateful if you could provide any information relevant to the proposed development that you may hold and/or highlight any issues that you feel should be addressed in the EIS. As you are the central office for your organisation, you may also wish to involve your regional or local office, if you deem it appropriate. For your information, it is proposed to submit the completed revised waste licence application and supporting Environmental Impact Statement to the Environmental Protection Agency by September 2004.
