- A copy of the Agency's audit reports on licensee performance
- A copy of the IPC and Waste Management registers maintained by the Agency, in accordance with the EPA Acts, 1992 and 2003 and the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2003
- Other information, as the Agency considers appropriate
