Dear Sir/madam,

I refer to your correspondence to Mr. Seamus Kelly dated 16/8/04 regarding Article 14 and Article 16 notices requesting additional information and clarifications in order to assess his application for a waste licence (WL 202-1). It is noted that the Article 12 and Article 13 compliance requirements stipulate that the requested information should be submitted to the Agency within one month of the notices (i.e within one month of 16/8/04). Due to the level of information required and in particular the need to collect dust samples over the period of a month we respectfully request further time in order to provide a comprehensive response to the notices. The collection and analysis of the dust samples will be completed by the end of October 2004 and we should be in a position to provide a full response to the Article 12 and 13 compliance requirements by that date.
