2. Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other
biological transformation processes).
3. Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds.
4. Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.
5. Regeneration of acids or bases.
6. Recovery of components used for pollution abatement.
7. Recovery of components from catalysts.
8. Oil re-refining or other re-uses of oil.
9. Use of any waste principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy.
10. The treatment of any waste on land with a consequential benefit for an agricultural activity or ecological system.
11. Use of waste obtained from any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
12. Exchange of waste for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
13. Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other
than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.
