Section B.3 – Planning Authority.

As part of Waste Licence Application 55-1, STI received planning permission reference S96A/0267 from South Dublin Co. Council for the 430 Beech Road site.

Planning Permission is currently pending for the 420 Beech Road site.

Section B.5 - Notices and Advertisement

Application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Waste Licence Review.

Sterile Technologies Ireland Ltd, 430 Beech Road, Western Industrial Estate, Naas Road, Dublin 12, is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency for a review of it's Waste Licence (No. 55-14), granted for a Healthcare Waste treatment plant located at Unit 430, Beech Road, Western Industrial Estate, Naas Road, Dublin 12 (National Grid Reference: Easting 3092, Northing 2314), to include an additional facility at 420 Beech Road, Western Industrial Estate, Naas Road, Dublin 12 (National Grid Reference: Easting 2313, Northing 3091). The principle activities carried out on both sites is specified in the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996, as follows:

"7. Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule, which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 10 of this Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcinations)."

"12. Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule."

"13. Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced." The principle activities carried out on both sites is also specified in the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996, as follows:

"2. Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes).

"3. Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds".

"4. Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials".

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"9. Use of any waste primarily as a fuel or other means to generate energy".

"13. Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced."

A copy of the Waste Licence review application, and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application will, as soon as is practicable after receipt of the application by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase at the offices of the Environmental Protection Agency, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, Co. Wexford.

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Section B.6 – Type of Activity

In addition to the principal activity which applies to the original licence application (Item 7 of the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Act) STI now seek addition activities to be conducted within the current building and the additional building.

As specified in the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996:

"12. Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule."

"13. Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced."

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"4. Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials".

"9. Use of any waste primarily as a fuel or other means to generate energy".

"13. Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced."

The principal activity to be carried out on the site is specified in the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Act, 1996 (as amended) as follows:-

"7. Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule, which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 10 of this Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcinations)."


Section B.7 – Fees

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
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
