re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing)
Regulations

Dear Mr Lynch

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a review of a waste licence relating to a facility at Sterile Technologies Ireland Ltd., 430 Beech Road, Western Industrial Estate, Naas Road. I am directed to advise you that it appears to the Agency that the notices published and erected or fixed in relation to the application are misleading or inadequate for the information of the public in the following respects:

- 1. The principal activity has not been identified as required by Articles 6(c) and 7(3)(b) i.e. the notices refer to all the activities being principal activities.
- 2. Other differences in the notices to the wording specified in the above regulations include;
  - The wording of the headings of the notices (Articles 6 and 7)
  - The wording in the notices for Class 9 of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Act
  - The wording of the last section of Article 6(e)

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

- 1. Publish an amended newspaper notice in accordance with Article 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice should be published in the newspaper which carried the original notice.
- 2. Replace the existing site notice with an amended notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.
- 3. Maintain the notice as amended at a location complying with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations for a period of two months following the making of the specified amendment.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:



- 1. An original of the newspaper and five copies of the relevant page of the newspaper in which the amended notice has been published.
- 2. An original and five copies of both a letter stating the date on which the amended site notice was fixed and a drawing showing its location on site.
- 3. An original and five copies of the text of the amended notice erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7.

The evidence requested should be submitted within three weeks of the date of this notice, in the form of an original and five copies.

Please note that the format of the application's register number has been revised to 55-2.
