O'Callaghan Moran & Associates (OCM) have been retained by *greenstar* Ltd to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to accompany an application to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for a review of Waste Licence Reg No 53-2 for its existing Materials Recovery & Transfer facility at Fassaroe, Bray, Co. Wicklow. As part of the EIS process, consultation with interested parties is being conducted. A brief description of the project is provided here as well as a Site Location Map.

Any queries or comments regarding the application can be submitted to OCM for consideration in the preparation of the EIS.

**Site Location:**

The facility is located at Fassaroe Lane, Bray, Co. Wicklow, approximately 350 m west of the M11 motorway that links north Wicklow with Dublin City (Figure 1.1). The facility is in the townland of Fassaroe approximately 3 km west of Bray town centre and 2 km north east of Enniskerry village

**Proposed Review:**

The main aims of the review are to increase the volume of waste that can be accepted annually from 129,500 tonnes of Commercial, Construction & Demolition and Household waste to 200,000 tonnes and to increase the volume of waste that can be composted from 2,000 tonnes annually to 10,000 tonnes. It is not proposed to change the types of waste accepted at the facility. It is also proposed to discontinue discharge of waste water to the on-site septic tank and Puraflow system and connect to a new foul sewer being installed on lands adjacent to the facility.



### **Existing Surface Water Drainage:**

The surface water drainage system in and around the site is dominated by the proximity of the nearby Glenmunder River at the north-eastern boundary. The Glenmunder ultimately drains to the River Dargle, which is a designated salmonid river.

Surface water emissions from the site are generally restricted to that of surface water run-off from hardstanding and roofed areas after a rainfall event (seasonal emission). The on-site surface water drainage network consists of a series of underground drainage channels which divert storm water from roofed and paved areas to soakaways which ultimately drain (via shallow sub-surface flow) to the Glenmunder River.

There are no direct discharges to surface water from the site activities. There is an indirect discharge via the soakways that take clean run-off from the site. Quarterly surface water monitoring has identified that water quality in the stream is generally satisfactory. There is evidence of occasional impacts associated with up stream sources, but no evidence that site activities have impacted on water quality.

### **Proposed Surface Water Drainage:**

It is not proposed to alter the existing surface water management infrastructure in the existing materials recovery area of the site. It is proposed to construct a new biowaste processing area consisting of a reception building and outdoor process areas. Run-off from the roof of the biowaste reception building and non process areas of the composting area will be collected and directed to the existing surface water drainage system.

All fuel tanks and oil storage compounds used on site are provided with adequate secondary containment to prevent spills or leaks from entering the surface water drainage system. These compounds will be used during the construction of the composting area.

All process wastewater from the site will discharge via a petrol/oil interceptor to the foul sewer which in turn connects to the municipal sewer that outfalls to the municipal wastewater treatment plant in Bray. The sanitary waste water will discharge directly to the foul sewer.
