Dear Ms. Hermansen,

I refer to the application by Greenstar Ltd to review the Waste Licence for its Fassaroe Depot Materials Recovery and Transfer Facility, the purpose of which is to amend certain conditions of the existing licence.

A recent audit of the facility (Ref. No. AROYOC) has highlighted a potential ambiguity in the licence conditions which may require clarification.

Condition 5.2.5 states: -

Other than waste accepted as the civic waste facility, waste shall only be accepted from known customers or new customers subject to initial waste profiling and waste characterisation offsite. The written records of this off-site waste profiling and characterisation shall be retained by the licensee for all active customers and for a two year period following termination of licensee/customer agreements. There shall be no casual public access to the facility.

It is Greenstar's understanding that the final sentence of Condition 5.2.5 restricts public access to the main materials recovery and transfer areas and buildings only. It is understood public access is permitted to the Civic Waste Facility on-site as specified in Condition 3.15.1 Civic Waste Facility. Greenstar's concern is that the final sentence of Condition 5.2.5 in its current form may in the future be interpreted to restrict public access to the licence area.
