

You are requested to obtain from the Environmental Protection Agency as to whether an Integrated Pollution Control Licence/Waste Licence will be required for the proposed activity. In this regard your attention is drawn to the Environmental Protection Agency Act, 1992 and the provisions of section 13 of the Waste Management (Amendment) Act, 2001 together with the provisions of the Waste Management Act, 1996. A copy of the request and the Agency's response should be forwarded to the Board by of reply. Please note that if the Environmental Protection Agency has previously indicated to you that a particular licence will be required a copy of such correspondence will suffice.

If the other information required is/are not received before the end of the specified period, the Board will dismiss or otherwise determine the appeal without further notice to you in accordance with section 11 of the 1992 Act. Your submission in response to this notice should be received by the Board not later than 5.30 p.m. on 25th April, 2002.
