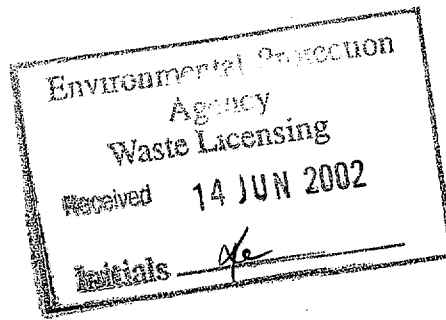

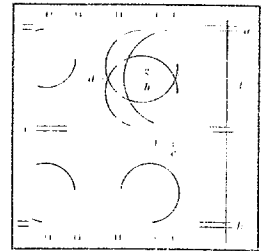

Dear Madam,

I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to the above-mentioned appeal.

The Board has received and considered your letter dated 23rd April, 2002 with enclosure from the Environmental Protection Agency. In view of the information submitted, the Board is of opinion that further information is necessary for the purpose of enabling it to determine the appeal.

In accordance with section 10 of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1992 you are required to submit, within **twenty one days** beginning on the date of this notice, the following information:

You are requested to obtain from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) information indicating whether an Integrated Pollution Control (IPC) Licence, a Waste Licence or both will be required for the proposed activity or activities in relation to the development the subject of the appeal. If it is the case that both IPC and Waste Licenses are required, the EPA should be asked to indicate the particular activities which required an IPC and a waste license. Your attention is drawn to the Environmental Protection Agency Act, 1992 and the provisions of section 13 of the Waste Management (Amendment) Act, 2001 together with the provisions of the Waste Management Act, 1996.

A copy of the request and the Agencies' response should be forwarded to the Board by way of reply.

If the document/particulars/other information required is/are not received before the end of the specified period, the Board will dismiss or otherwise determine the appeal without further notice to you in accordance with section 11 of the 1992 Act. Your submission in response to this notice should be received by the Board not later than **5.30 p.m. on 1st July, 2002.**

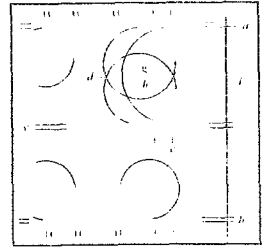
