Dear Ms Burke

I am to refer to your application for a waste licence in respect of your proposed facility at Carranstown, County Meath. As indicated in the application it is proposed to carry on a waste recovery activity namely Class 9 of the Fourth Schedule "Use of any waste principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy". It is proposed to incinerate waste and in the process generate energy.

An examination of the technical information submitted with the application indicates that the thermal input of the plant will be in excess of 50 MW. This size of plant is also covered by the requirements for IPC licensing in that Class 2.1 relates to "The production of energy in combustion plant the rated thermal input of which is equal to or greater than 50MW other than any such plant which makes direct use of the products of combustion in a manufacturing process". The plant as proposed will not make direct use of the products of combustion.

The facility must be licensed by the Agency before it can commence operations.

The Agency wishes to bring the above facts to your information so that you can consider the matter further and to afford you an opportunity to seek such legal or other advice, as you consider necessary.

You are requested to advise the Agency as to how you wish to proceed.
