I am to acknowledge receipt of your correspondence to the Agency dated 16/11/04 received on 16/11/04, in relation to the above referenced waste licence application.

I am to advise that, as the application process has reached the stage where the Agency has made its proposed decision, the Agency is prohibited from considering any objection which does not fulfil the requirements of Section 42 of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2003.
