

**Extract from the 425<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Agency, held on 22 October 2004, in Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, Wexford**

**4. Recommended Decision on a Waste Licence**

- (i) *Licensee:* **Indaver Ireland (Branch of Indaver NV)**  
**Carranstown**  
**Duleek**  
**Co Meath**  
*Register of Licence No 167-1*

The Directors considered a revised recommended decision from the Office of Licensing and Guidance, taking account of the amendments agreed by the Directors at their meeting held on 12 October 2004. The Directors had deferred a decision on this matter pending the submission of the revised document. The following documentation was again tabled: 127 submissions; summary report of the inspector and report from the Programme Manager, OLG; copy of the licence application.

P Larkin gave a presentation and indicated some further minor amendments (marked\*) made by the Office of Licensing and Guidance, for reasons of clarity, when revising the recommended decision

The Directors accepted these amendments and noted some further changes, as follows:

**Recommended Decision**

*Introduction*

Amend 3<sup>rd</sup> para to read: Only *residual* non-hazardous waste

*Part I – Activities Licensed*

Clarify and correct description of Class 7 and Class 2 if necessary

*Glossary of Terms*

Hours of Waste Acceptance: Simplify wording to clarify

SCADA System: Delete

*Condition*

- 1.11 Insert new condition as follows: *Having regard to the nature of the works and arrangements necessary in connection with the commencement of the waste activities this licence shall have effect for five years from the date the licence is granted.*
- 2.3.2.3 \*Amended to read: not later than six months from the date of *commencement of waste activities*, submit to the Agency...
- 3.3.2d) Amend to read: an emergency *out-of-hours* contact telephone number
- 3.14.4 Insert new condition as follows: *The Licensee shall have in storage an adequate supply of containment booms and/or suitable absorbent material to contain and absorb any spillage at the facility.*
- 3.20.3 Amend to read: ...implemented as agreed and *a report on the implementation shall be* submitted to the Agency on completion.
- 3.22.5 \*This condition was rephrased for clarity.
- 5.7 \*Deleted – it is only relevant to landfill
- 6.2 Clarify wording for consistency
- 8.2.3a) \*Amended to read: ...*or new customers, accepted at the facility*

- 8.2.3e) Amend to read: The licensee shall, where possible, *prior to accepting the waste at the incineration plant*, determine the mass...  
Delete last line.
- 8.3 \*Amended *and/or* to read *or*
- 8.14 Amend to read: ...conveyed *only* by holders...
- 9.3c) Amend to read: *isolate the source of such emission*
- 9.4.4 Amend to read: ...quantity *or* the quality of the water supply, this shall be *treated as an emergency*.  
Delete last sentence. Clarify wording of all sub-conditions for consistency.
- 10.2 Amend last sentence to read: ...*may result in environmental pollution*.
- 11.3.4 \*Amended to read as 2 separate conditions for clarity, 11.3.4 and new condition 11.7
- 11.6.2b) \*Clarified to read: *A report of annual audits undertaken by the licensee of the waste disposal treatment and recovery sites for the residues and other wastes dispatched from the facility*.

- A1 Delete 3<sup>rd</sup> column and insert quantity above the Table
- B4 \*Deleted second (redundant) 'A' weighting reference
- C1.2 Delete 'Ammonia' monitoring
- C4 \*Amended to include *Electro Filter Ash* and *Flue Gas Residuals*  
Delete *Note 1*.
- C5 \*Inserted WMO Standards under Analysis Method/Technique
- D \*Amended for clarification

Following further discussion and based on all documentation before them, the Directors approved the recommended decision to grant a licence, as modified, to Indaver Ireland (Branch of Indaver NV), Carranstown, Duleek, Co Meath, Register of Licence No 167-1, subject to the conditions as set out in the licence document.
