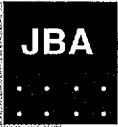

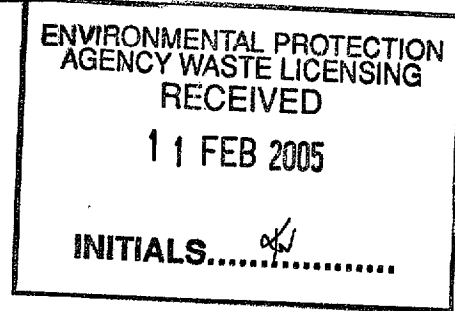

2. Night time lighting shall be confined to the minimum required for security,  
operational and maintenance purposes in both spacial and temporal terms.  
**Reason:** To protect the amenities of residential properties in the area.
