re: Notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr. Buckley,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Crag Avenue, Clondalkin Industrial Estate, Clondalkin, Co. Dublin. Having examined the documentation submitted and your response to the Article 14(2)(b)(ii) letter of 21 July 2004 received by the Agency on 1 March 2005, I am to advise that the Agency is of the view that the documentation does not comply with Article 12 and Article 13 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2000-2002.

You are therefore requested, in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) of the regulations, to take the steps and supply the information detailed below:

1. Supply detailed information on the following in relation to the proposed conversion of waste vegetable oil to biodiesel:
 - a. Quantity and EWC codes of all wastes arising from the process;
 - b. Arrangements for off-site treatment or disposal/recovery of wastes (including KOH fertilisers) arising from the process;
 - c. Composition, quantity, level and rate of effluent arising from the process and details of the treatment or disposal of the effluent;
 - d. Complete Table 1.10 for each raw material, substance or preparation to be utilised in the activity.

2. Having regard to the Agency's "Waste Licensing Waste Recovery/Disposal Activities Guidance Note for Applicants", Section L.3 *Financial Provision*, provide information for the purpose of enabling the Agency to make a determination in relation to the matter specified in paragraph (d) of Section 40(4) of the Waste Management Act, 1996 to 2003.

3. Submit information in relation to the requirements of Article 12(1)(n) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2000-2002, having regard to the proposed conversion of waste vegetable oil to biodiesel.
4. Having regard to the Agency's "Waste Licensing Waste Recovery/Disposal Activities Guidance Note for Applicants", Section G, provide detailed information on the source of funding for decommissioning and aftercare of the facility, after the cessation of the activity, particularly in the case of insolvency.

ARTICLE 13 COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Provide details of the proposed process for conversion of waste vegetable oil to biodiesel.


Your reply to this notice should include a revised non-technical summary (Waste Licence Application Form and EIS) which reflects the information you supply in compliance with the notice, insofar as that information impinges on the non-technical summary.

In the case where any drawings already submitted are subject to revision consequent on this request, a revised drawing should be prepared in each case. It is not sufficient to annotate the original drawing with a textual correction. Where such revised drawings are submitted, provide a list of drawing titles, drawing numbers and revision status, which correlates the revised drawings with the superseded versions.

Please supply the information in the form of a one original plus two copies within 4 weeks of the date of this notice. In addition submit sixteen copies of the requested information to the Agency in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM.
