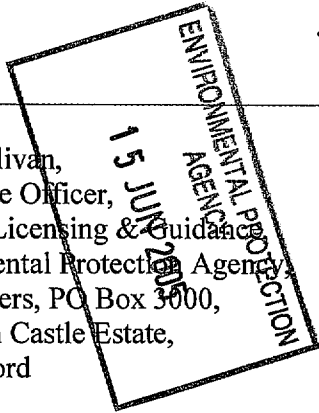

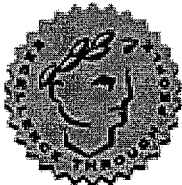
Dear Sir/Madam

I refer to the application for a Discharge Licence by Greyhound Recycling & Recovery Ltd dated 11<sup>th</sup> May 2005.

South Dublin County Council must refuse to grant permission to the EPA for a discharge of trade effluent under Section 52 of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2003 from the Greyhound Recycling & Recovery Ltd premises as detailed on the application due to the lack of information.

An application for consent to discharge trade effluent under Section 52 of the Acts should contain the following:

- Details of all and any trade effluent generated on site, which is intended for discharge to the foul sewer.
- Details of any treatment to be carried out on the trade effluent prior to discharge.



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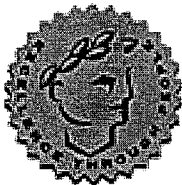
- A map detailing the foul and surface water drainage on site.

Under the conditions of the Section of the Acts, South Dublin County Council are required to reply within the specified period, hence due to the lack of the above information, at this time, we must refuse the application for consent to discharge trade effluent.
