I, Joe McLoughlin, Ardcolum, Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim and, within two weeks of the publication of this notice, making application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Waste Licence for the handling of dry recyclables and the reloading of waste, prior to transfer to landfill, at my facility at Ardcolum, Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim, National Grid Reference: E1959 N3102. The activities concerned, in accordance with the Third & Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Acts 1996-2003, are as follows: Third Schedule, Classes 11 (Blending or mixture prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule) and 13 (Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced). Fourth Schedule, Classes 2 (Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological transformation processes), 3 (Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds), 4 (Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials), 11 (Use of waste obtained from any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule) and 13 (Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced). The principal activity being Third Schedule, Class 11. Quantities of waste being handled at this facility will not exceed 25,000 tonnes per annum. Plant being used at the facility will include balers, conveyor, forklift, bulkers, compactors, skips and grab. A copy of the application for a waste licence and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase, at the headquarters of the Agency.
