Re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing)
Regulations

Dear Mr Quinlivan,

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Joe McLoughlin Waste Disposal, Ardcolum, Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim. I am directed to advise you that it appears to the Agency, following a Site Notice Inspection on the 14th March 2005, that the notice erected or fixed in relation to the application does not comply with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 395/2004) for the following reason:

The notice specifies more than one principal activity and is based on older (now revised) legislation. Only one principal activity should be identified in accordance with Article 6(c) of the Regulations.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

- 1. Replace the existing site notice with an amended notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004.
- 2. Maintain the site notice as amended at a location complying with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004.
- 3. The above requirements should be carried out within **two weeks** of the date of this notice.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

- 1. An original and two copies of a letter stating the date on which the amended site notice was fixed.
- 2. An original and two copies of a drawing showing its location on site.
- 3. An original and two copies of the text of the amended notice erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7.

The evidence requested should be submitted within two weeks of the date of this notice, in the form of one original plus two copies.
