Re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr Quinlivan

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Joe McLoughlin Waste Disposal, Ardcolumn, Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim. I am directed to advise you that it appears to the Agency that the notices published and erected or fixed in relation to the application do not comply with Articles 6 and 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 395/2004) for the following reason:

The notices specify more than one principal activity. I wish to point out that only one principal activity should be identified in accordance with Article 6(c) of the Regulations.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

1. Publish an amended newspaper notice in accordance with Article 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice should be published in the newspaper that carried the original notice.
2. Replace the existing site notice with an amended notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.
3. Maintain the site notice as amended at a location complying with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004.
4. An amended written notice should be given to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations including the specified amendments.
5. The above requirements should be carried out within **two weeks** of the date of this notice.



The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

1. An original of the newspaper and two copies of the relevant page of the newspaper in which the amended notice has been published.
2. An original and two copies of a letter stating the date on which the amended site notice was fixed.
3. An original and two copies of a drawing showing its location on site.
4. An original and two copies of the text of the amended notice erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7.
5. An original and two copies of the amended written notice to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9.

The evidence requested should be submitted within **two weeks** of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit one copy on a CD-ROM to the Agency. The e-file should be saved as a 'pdf' file, read only status.

Please note that the format of the application's register number has been revised to 216- Please direct all correspondence in relation to this matter to the *Licensing Unit, Office of Licensing & Guidance, Environmental Protection Agency, Headquarters, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford* quoting the register number.
