Re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing)
Regulations

Dear Mr Quinlivan

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Joe McLoughlin Waste Disposal, Ardcolum, Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim. I am directed to advise you that it appears to the Agency that the notices published and erected or fixed in relation to the application do not comply with Articles 6 and 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 395/2004) for the following reason:

The notices specify more than one principal activity. I wish to point out that only one principal activity should be identified in accordance with Article 6(c) of the Regulations.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

- 1. Publish an amended newspaper notice in accordance with Article 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice should be published in the newspaper that carried the original notice.
- 2. Replace the existing site notice with an amended notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations.
- 3. Maintain the site notice as amended at a location complying with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004.
- 4. An amended written notice should be given to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations including the specified amendments.
- 5. The above requirements should be carried out within **two weeks** of the date of this notice.



The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

- 1. An original of the newspaper and two copies of the relevant page of the newspaper in which the amended notice has been published.
- 2. An original and two copies of a letter stating the date on which the amended site notice was fixed.
- 3. An original and two copies of a drawing showing its location on site.
- 4. An original and two copies of the text of the amended notice erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7.
- 5. An original and two copies of the amended written notice to the relevant planning authority in accordance with Article 9.

The evidence requested should be submitted within **two weeks** of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit one copy on a CD-ROM to the Agency. The e-file should be saved as a 'pdf' file, read only status.
