required for any I refer to your correspondence to Mr. Seamus Kelly dated 16/8/04 regarding an Article 16 notice requesting that a new daytime noise survey be carried out at the site. It was requested that the noise survey include for monitoring at four boundary locations and at all noise sensitive locations within a 1km radius of the site. Consent

As can be seen from the attached map a number of dwellings are located within a 1km radius of the site (51 in total). It is proposed that daytime monitoring is carried out at all dwellings within a 500m radius of the site with an additional three locations just outside of this radius.

A housing estate is located within the 500m radius, it is considered that it would be adequate to carry out noise monitoring at two of the houses within the estate which would be representative of the noise levels experienced at the other houses within the estate.

As requested noise monitoring will also be carried out at the northwestern, western, southern and eastern boundaries of the site.

This will involve a total of 17 monitoring locations which will adequately represent the existing noise environment in the vicinity of the site.


