The Company

Thorntons Recycling Centre Ltd is a subsidiary of Padraig Thornton Waste Disposal Ltd (PTWDL). The company provides a progressive service in terms of waste management to the population of Leinster and beyond. PTWDL currently handles waste from Kildare, Meath, Westmeath, Offaly, Fingal, Dublin City, South Dublin, Dun Laoghaire-Rathdown, Wicklow, Wexford, Galway, Sligo and Waterford. The total volume handled by the company annually is currently running at approximately 300,000 tonnes. The amount of waste from each county varies depending on contracts as a significant portion of this waste is collected by local authorities or other waste management companies. PTWDL's collection area consists of south County Meath, north County Kildare and the Metropolitan Area of Dublin. The company has collected waste from these three counties for over 20 years and has brought these wastes to its recycling centre/transfer station in Killeen Road, Dublin for approximately 10 years.

It is the policy of the Company to ensure the health and safety of all employees by maintaining a safe place and system of work. This policy is based on the requirements of employment legislation including the Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations, 1995 (S.I. No 138 of 1995).

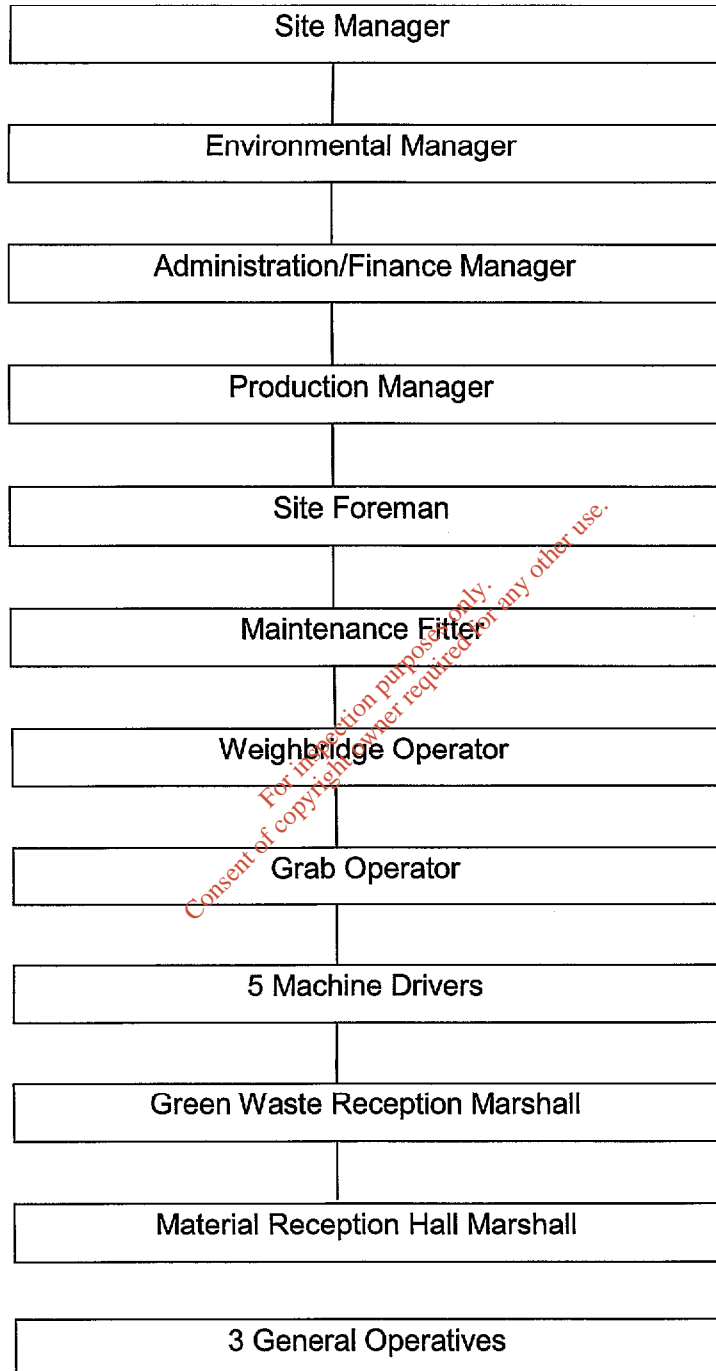
