

Extract from the 423rd Meeting of the Agency, held on 12 October 2004, in Headquarters, Johnstown Castle Estate, Wexford.

- (ii) *Licensee:* **Indaver Ireland**

The Directors considered a recommendation from the Office of Licensing and Guidance that the Agency approve the recommended decision. The following documentation was submitted: proposed decision; 7 submissions; summary report of the inspector. A copy of the licence application was tabled.

The Directors noted that the Office of Licensing and Guidance had had regard to all relevant waste management plans, in accordance with Section 40 of the Waste Management Act, when recommending the decision.

Inspector's Report

The Directors noted Cork County Council did not grant planning permission for the incineration plant and that An Bord Pleanála subsequently granted planning permission, following an oral hearing.

Recommended Decision

Introduction:

Reduce tonnage of waste to 100,000 tonnes per year for each phase.

Glossary of Terms

Include definition for '*residual municipal waste*'

Amend definition of 'Sludge' to read: The accumulation of solids resulting from chemical coagulation, flocculation and/or sedimentation after water or waste water treatment *with greater than 2% dry matter.*

12. Clarify that the *Financial Charges and Provisions* are consistent with those agreed for licence No. 167-1, taking account that licence No. 186-1 has 2 incinerators and that these plants will not be built in 2004.

Schedule

- A Amend to take account of reduced tonnage allowed.
 Modify to take account of categories of waste in licence application.
 Delete *Municipal Waste* from fluidised bed list.
 Allow residual municipal waste in moving grate incinerator, with a note as follows:
Residual Municipal waste may also be incinerated in fluidised bed incinerator after the moving grate incinerator has commenced operation.

Following detailed discussion, the Directors decided to refer the Recommended Decision back to the Office of Licensing and Guidance to incorporate all of the agreed amendments. They requested that a revised document, incorporating the amendments, be submitted to the Board as soon as possible for a final decision.
