4. **Request for Oral Hearing**

(i) Indaver Ireland – Reg No 186-1

The Directors considered documentation from the Office of Licensing and Guidance concerning a total of 11 requests received for an Oral Hearing of the objections raised in relation to the proposed decision on the Waste Licence application of Indaver Ireland, Ringaskiddy, Co Cork, Register of Licence No 186-1. The Inspector dealing with the application had examined all the requests and considered that they satisfied the criteria set down by the Agency in relation to Oral Hearings. Following discussion on the issues raised in the Inspector's Report, dated 13 December, 2004, the Directors decided that an Oral Hearing should be heard.

The Directors decided that Dr Jonathan Derham, Senior Inspector in the Office of Licensing and Guidance, should be appointed as Chairperson of the Oral Hearing Committee. It was also decided that Mr Brendan Kissane, Senior Inspector in the Office of Environmental Enforcement, would assist the Chairperson.
