## APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE LICENCE

AVR-Safeway Ltd., with registered offices at Corrin, Fermoy, Co. Cork is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Review of the Waste License 50-1 in respect of this facility.

The following will be constructed in addition to the existing waste transfer station facilities:

- Fuel Blending Facility consisting of 6 number above ground liquid storage tanks (T-1 T-6) of capacity of 29 to 150 m³, ancillary piping, pumps (3 number), bund, control system and wet scrubber/carbon filter pollution abatement device
- Extension to the existing warehouse of about 240 m<sup>2</sup> and new canteen.

It is proposed to manage up to 72,000 tonnes/annum of commercial/enterprise and industrial waste, primarily hazardous.
