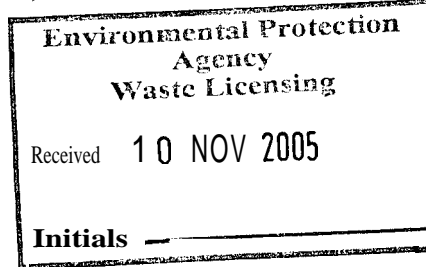

# APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A WASTE LICENCE

AVR-Safeway Ltd., with registered offices at Corrin, Fermoy, Co. Cork is applying to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Review of the Waste License 50-1 in respect of this facility.

The following will be constructed in addition to the existing waste transfer station facilities:

- Fuel Blending Facility consisting of 6 number above ground liquid storage tanks (T-1 – T-6) of capacity of 29 to 150 m<sup>3</sup>, ancillary piping, pumps (3 number), bund, control system and wet scrubber/carbon filter pollution abatement device.
- Extension to the existing warehouse of about 240 m<sup>2</sup> and new canteen.
- Relocation of existing and installation of 2 number external storage boxes.

It is proposed to manage up to 72,000 tonnes/annum of commercial/enterprise and industrial waste, primarily hazardous.

The relevant waste disposal and waste recovery activities, as per the New Third and Fourth Schedules of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2003, and the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004) to which this application relates are:

### *Licensed Waste Disposal Activities, in accordance with the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2003*

Class 7.	Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs <b>1 to 5</b> or paragraphs <b>8 to 10</b> of this Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcination).
Class <b>11</b> .	Blending or mixture prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
Class <b>12</b> .	Repackaging prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
Class <b>13</b> .	Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

### *Licensed Waste Recovery Activities, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2003*

Class <b>1</b>	Solvent reclamation or regeneration..
Class <b>2</b>	Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents (including composting and other biological processes)
Class <b>3</b>	Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds.
Class <b>4</b>	Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.
Class <b>8</b>	Oil re-refining or other re-uses of oil.
Class <b>11</b> .	Use of waste obtained from any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
Class <b>12</b> .	Exchange of waste for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.
Class <b>13</b> .	Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced. <b>PRINCIPAL ACTIVITY</b>
