re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr O'Flynn

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at Corrin, Fermoy, Co Cork. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 7 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice as erected or fixed on the facility or premises contravene Article. 7(3)(b) of the regulations.

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

1. Replace the existing site notice with the amended notice that complies with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, ensuring the Principal Activity is identified.
2. The text of the notice should identify the review of the licence 50-1.
3. Maintain the notice as amended at the location complying with Article 7 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations for a period of two months following the making of the specified amendments.


The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

1. The text of the amended notice erected or fixed in accordance with Article 7.

The evidence requested should be submitted within two weeks of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency.
