I refer to your recent notice to Greenstar Ltd., La Vallée, Fassaroe, Bray, Co. Wicklow dated 22/9/05 requesting information in accordance with Article 14 (2)(b)(ii) with regard to waste licence application 220-1. Greenstar have commissioned White Young Green (WYG) to carry out the required surveys and provide the information to the EPA. We are presently in the process of compiling the information, however, the requested dust analyses will require dust jars to be installed and maintained at the site for a period of one month prior to their analysis. In light of this it will not be possible to provide the information to you within the timeframe indicated in your notice (by 22110/05). However, we expect to complete the dust analyses by the end of next month and respectfully request this additional time to provide a comprehensive submission to yourselves.
