Itake it that this means all tanks including the floor washing tank will be at or above ground level, though whether this statement applies to the sewage treatment plant is unclear.

In view of the importance of the aquifer, I recommend that a site investigation be carried out to determine the nature and depth of the overburden to bedrock on this specific site, and that excavation for a treatment plant be clarified, with a view to minimising risk to the aquifer on the site.

■ also recommend that a site sampling point be installed at the point of discharge of surface water from the site to the open drain, and that the outfall location and the path of the drain be clearly marked on a map.

Section 3.2.12 proposed that for washings will be brought to Enniscorthy sewage treatment plant for treatment, at a rate of some 4 cubic metres per month. It may be that the new Courtown sewage treatment plant, when completed, may be more appropriate, and so I recommend that the reception point be left to the discretion of Wexford County Council.
