- 8.6.1 Amend to read: *Waste shall be accepted at the facility only from*.....
- 10 Clarify if additional condition for *Aftercare* is required.
- 11.10 Amend 3rd sub-condition (c) to read: volume of trade *effluent, in cubic metres*...
- 12.3.1 Amend to clarify financial provision for remedial actions.
