



Type of Waste Activity: Brief Technical Description

The Principal Activity for which a waste licence is applied for by Monopower Ltd is; Class 9 of the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2003, "Use of any waste principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy".

The activity proposed is a biomass combined heat **and** power plant (CHP). The biomass used will constitute Spent Mushroom Compost **(SMC)** and Poultry Litter (PL) predominantly, both of which are readily available in the region. **The** plant will also be designed to operate on Wood Chips (WC), where available.

The biomass plant when operating at full capacity will be capable of handling 353,000 tonnes of biomass per year. This will comprise 198,000 tonnes of SMC and 155,000 tonnes of PL.

The proposed plant will have a capacity to generate 22.5MW of electricity per annum, which will be sold to the national grid, with a small amount of usage on-site.

The activity to be carried out at this site can also be classified as co-incineration under directive 2000/76/EC on the incineration of weste. 'Co-incineration plant' is defined in point 5 of Article 3 of this directive as;

"any stationary or mobile plant whose main purpose is the generation of energy or production of material products and;

- which used waste as a regular or additional fuel; or
- in which waste is thermally treated for the purpose of disposal.

If co-incineration takes place in such a way that the main purpose of the plant is not the generation of energy of the production of material products but rather the thermal treatment of waste, the plant shall be regarded as an incineration plant within the meaning of point 4 (of article 3 of the directive).

Therefore Monopowec Biomass CHP plant is a co-incineration plant as it is a stationary plant, whose main purpose is the generation of energy and which uses waste as a regular fuel. This definition of co-incineration also equates to the principal activity stipulated in this waste licence application i.e. Class 9 of the Fourth Schedule "Use of any waste principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy".

Under Directive 2000/76/EC therefore the activity is not defined as an incineration plant.
