
I would direct you in particular to Section 2 of the EPA inspectors report and Sections 2.1, 3.1 and 3.2 (as may be relevant) of the objection.

The EPA would welcome your assistance in assessing the technical (hydrogeological) aspects of the objection from the applicants, and would appreciate any conclusions/advice you can give. The legislative provisions for consideration of objections do allow the EPA to request supporting information from the applicant. So if you believe your assessment of this objection would be assisted by technical data/studies not present in the objection/application documentation then please advise me as soon as possible so that I may request same from the applicant.

Given the existing environmental pressures at the Blessington site, it would be our wish to conclude assessment of the objection in a reasonably short period. To that end I would be pleased to hear from you by 10th October.
