Decision of the Agency, under Section 40(1) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005

Further to notice dated the 12th day of July 2005, the Agency in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005, for the reasons hereinafter set out in the attached Decision, grants this waste licence to Roadstone Dublin Limited, Fortunestown, Tallaght, Dublin 24, to carry on the waste activities set out below at Roadstone Dublin Remediation Landfill, Dillonsdown, Deerpark, Newpaddocks and Santryhill Townlands, Blessington, County Wicklow subject to twelve Conditions, as set out in the schedules attached thereto.

Licensed Waste Activities

Waste Disposal Activities, in accordance with the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005:

Class 1.	Deposit on, in or under land (including landfill).
Class 13.	Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced.

Waste Recovery Activities, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005:

Class 4.	Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.
Class 10.	The treatment of any waste on land with a consequential benefit for an agricultural activity or ecological system.
Class 13.	Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

The carrying on of the following activity is refused:

Refused waste disposal activity, in accordance with the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005:

Class 5.	Specially engineered landfill, including placement into lined discrete cells which are capped and isolated from one another and the environment.
	Reason: The construction of lined and capped landfill cells is not provided for in the licence, as it requires the removal off-site of all domestic and commercial and other non-inert wastes to an approved disposal/recovery facility.
