In accordance with Article 36 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a waste licence to Indaver Ireland, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at Indaver Ireland, Ringaskiddy, County Cork. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision

The Agency's decision was made following consideration of the licence application, the objections to the Agency's proposed decision, and the Chairperson's report on the Oral Hearing, in accordance with the Waste Management Act, 1996 to 2005 and related Regulations.

The application, objections, oral hearing report and associated documents are available for inspection or purchase at the Agency's Headquarters in accordance with the Regulations. Arrangements are being put in place to provide all documentation relating to this licence application on the Agency's website at <http://www.epa.ie/Licensing/WasteLicensing/SearchforaWasteLicence> from midday on 25 November 2005.

Also enclosed is a copy of a draft Guidance Note on Environmental Management Systems and Reporting to the Agency. Conditions of the waste licence for the above facility require that the Agency is notified of specified matters and that reports and other materials are forwarded at defined intervals. The Guidance Note is intended to assist you in the production of this information.

Please use the register number of the waste licence, 186-1, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and three copies of all items in the correspondence.

You will be contacted in due course by an inspector in the Office of Environmental Enforcement who will discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.
