re: Notice in accordance with Article 21(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004

Dear Mr McCarthy

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence review relating to a facility at Tramore Waste Disposal Site, Tramore Intake & Tramore Burrows, Tramore, Co. Waterford, which was received on 08/12/2004.

As advised by the Agency notice in accordance with Article 14(2)(b)(ii) dated 21/03/2005, and further correspondence dated 10/06/2005, the application does not comply with Article 12 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The Agency's notice requested you to supply the outstanding information. It is noted that the requested information has not been received to date.

In light of the foregoing, I am to advise you that the Agency is of the opinion that the review application has been abandoned. In accordance with the Regulations, you are hereby required, within twenty-eight days commencing on the date of this notice, to make to the Agency a submission in writing as to why the application should not be considered as having been withdrawn.

It should be noted that, any time after 24/03/2006 and after considering the submission (if any) which you make pursuant to this notice, the Agency may declare that the application (Waste Licence Application Register 75-2) shall be regarded as withdrawn.
