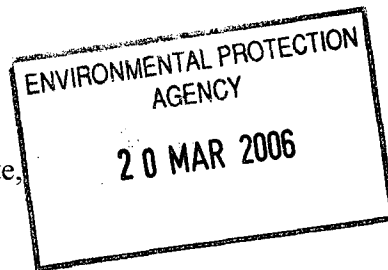

Dear Anne,


I refer to your letter of March 14th. Please note that my letter in relation to the invalid objection submitted by Arthur Cox solicitors was not a submission on the objections. It was to point out that the invalid objection submitted by Arthur Cox, on behalf of a person or body who wishes to remain anonymous, does not comply with the legal requirements of an objection, as set out in the Waste Management Act 1996 and that, therefore, the EPA is precluded from considering it as an objection. It is, of course, not possible in law to make a submission on an invalid objection.

I would appreciate it if the EPA would confirm that they acknowledge that the document submitted by Arthur Cox solicitors is an invalid objection.

I intend to make a submission on the valid objections prior to the specified date.
