I refer to the Agency's letter of 3rd March 2006 in reply to your company's correspondence relating to the proposed decision on the review of above referenced waste licence.

The Agency has noted that your letter of objection was on behalf of an anonymous client and does not contain the name and address of the objector. That being the case the Agency has determined that it is not a valid objection as it does not meet the requirements of Section 42(4)(b) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996-2005 that requires an objection to 'state the name and address of the objector'. In accordance with the provisions of Section 42 (5) (a) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996-2005 the Agency must therefore determine it to be invalid.
