Thank you for your letters (three no.) received 28th February, 2006.

I note in your first letter you request copies of all correspondence relating to the above mentioned file received by the Agency since 17th February, including the EIS. I am to advise that no EIS was necessary in relation to this application and no further correspondence has been received by the Agency since 15th February, 2006.

I am to advise however that a proposed decision issued in respect of this review on 10th March, 2006. I have enclosed a copy of the proposed decision for your information.

I refer to your second letter dated 28th February, 2006 regarding Safeway's Fuel Blending Facility and advise we understand that the building work on the Fuel Blending Facility is scheduled to start during the 2nd Quarter of 2006.

With regard to your 3rd letter, dated 28th February, 2006, which requested an update regarding reply to your earlier letters (four no.). I am to advise that the relevant letters have been referred on to Ms. Jacinta Ponzi and Mr Peter Cunningham with regard to reply where appropriate.

I have followed up the situation regarding the other letters (2 no.) and advise as follows;

In reply to your letter dated 23rd January, 2006, it is a matter for Safeways to decide what information it considers appropriate to display on its' website, including correspondence from the Agency.

In reply to your 2nd letter dated 23rd January, 2006, I am to advise that there is no waste water treatment plant on site, waste water is removed off-site for treatment.
