re: Notification pursuant to Article 16(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing)
Regulations, in respect of a Waste Licence application for Brownfield Restoration
Ireland Ltd at Whitestown Lower, Co Wicklow,

Dear Mr Wall

I am to refer to the above referenced waste licence application and to further information submitted in response to the Agency notice of 22 March 2005.

I am to advise that the Agency considers that the said further information contains significant additional data in relation to the effects on the environment of the development.

Accordingly, pursuant to Article 16(2) of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency requires you to publish a notice in the form specified below in a newspaper <u>circulating in the district</u> in which the said activities are carried on or would be carried on.

The required notice shall be published within two weeks of the date of this notification, on a day which is not a Saturday a Sunday or a public holiday.

## Required Form of Notice:

The notice shall contain as a heading: WASTE MANAGEMENT (LICENSING) REGULATIONS, - APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR A WASTE LICENCE REGISTER NO. 204-1 and shall contain the following information:

a) that (name and address of the applicant) has made an application for a waste licence to the Agency in respect of a (type of facility) at (location or postal address of facility concerned);



- b) that an environmental impact statement in respect of development with a roposed to be carried out at the facility was submitted to the Agency as part of the Agency as part o
- c) that the Agency has informed you that it considers that further information which you have submitted to it in reply to Agency notices contains significant additional data in relation to the effects on the environment of development which comprises or is for the purposes of the waste disposal and waste recovery activities to which the application relates;
- d) that the application, the EIS and the further information etc. are available for public inspection at the Agency's headquarters at Johnstown Castle, Wexford;
- e) that any person may make a submission in writing about the application to the Environmental Protection Agency, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following items in relation to compliance with the above requirements:

- 1. On the date of publication of the notice, a facsimile copy of an extract from the relevant newspaper containing the notice as published;
- 2. Within five days of publication of the required notice, an original of the newspaper and four copies of the relevant page of the newspaper in which the notice was published.
