I am to acknowledge receipt of your correspondence to the Agency dated 28 March 2006 received on 6 April 2006, in relation to the above referenced waste licence application.

I refer to the Agency's notification to you on 10 March 2006 informing you of its proposed decision on the above application.

I am to advise that, as the application process has reached the stage where the Agency has made its proposed decision, the Agency is prohibited from considering any correspondence which does not fulfil the requirements of Section 42 of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005. As your correspondence is not a valid objection, the Agency cannot consider it and consequently it is returned herewith.

However I am to advise to contact Mr Brendan Foley, at the Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, Inniscara, County Cork, with regard to your query on trigger levels in relation to this site.

It should be noted, however, that the Agency is committed to openness, fairness and transparency in its decision making process and I can assure you that you will have access to all documentation in relation to this licence application including the report and recommendations of the technical committee (if valid objections are received in relation to the proposed decision) and the final decision of the Agency.

The Agency will notify you of its final decision on the waste licence application in due course.
