re: Notice in accordance with Article 8 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations

Dear Mr Storan

I am to refer to the above referenced application for a waste licence relating to a facility at ONYX Ireland Ltd, Carrignard, Six Cross Roads, Business Park, Waterford City. I am directed to advise you of a failure of compliance with Article 6 of the relevant Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations. The notice published in respect of the application contravenes Article. 6c of the regulations (S.I. 395 of 2004).

The Agency therefore requires you, in accordance with Article 8 of the regulations, to

1. Publish an updated newspaper notice ensuring that the quantity and nature of the waste types proposed are indicated. Note the notice must be in accordance with the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations S.I. 395 of 2004.

The Agency further requires you to submit the following evidence in relation to compliance with the above requirement:

1. A copy of the complete newspaper in which the new advertisement was placed.

The evidence requested should be submitted within one month of the date of this notice, in the form of a one original plus two copies. In addition submit two copies of the requested information in electronic searchable PDF format on a CD-ROM to the Agency.
