re: Notice in accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, in respect of a Waste Licence Application by Dublin City Council for a facility at Labre Park Civic Amenity Site, Ballyfermot, Dublin 10.

Dear Sir/Madam,

In accordance with Article 34 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a waste licence to Dublin City Council, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at Labre Park Civic Amenity Site, Ballyfermot, Dublin 10. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision.

This decision was made following consideration of the objection(s) and technical committee report to the Agency's proposed decision in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005 and related Regulations. The objections, technical committee report and associated documents are available for inspection or purchase at the Agency's headquarters.

Also enclosed is a copy of a <u>draft</u> Guidance Note on Environmental Management Systems and Reporting to the Agency. Conditions of the waste licence for the above facility require that the Agency is notified of specified matters and that reports and other materials are forwarded at defined intervals. The draft Guidance Note is intended to assist you in the production of this information. It is the Agency's intention to complete a review of this document in due course.

Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0221-01, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and three copies of all items in the correspondence.

It should be noted that the Agency requires notification, in writing, from the licensee at least one week in advance of the commencement of the licensed waste activities, for compliance with Section 41(6) of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005.

You will be contacted in due course by an inspector in the Office of Environmental Enforcement, Environmental Protection Agency, McCumiskey House, Richview, Clonskeagh Road, Dublin 14 who will discuss the implementation of the conditions of the licence.
