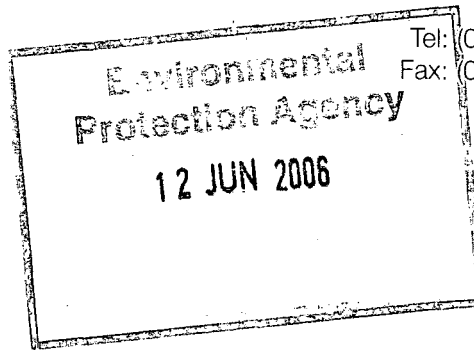

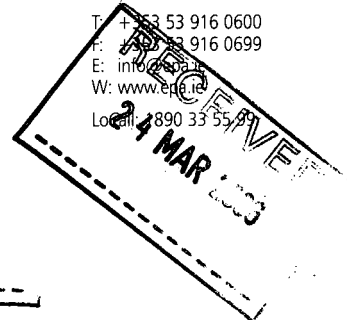
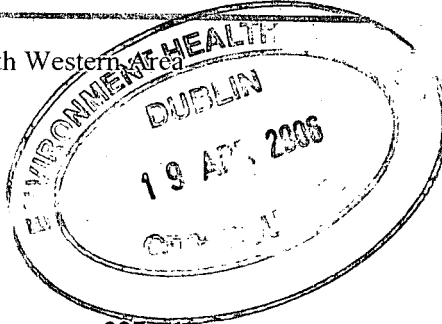

- and the Agency shall not give notice of a proposed decision under Section 42(2) of the Acts before the expiry of a period of one month following the date of a relevant -
- (a) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 14(2)(a), or
  - (b) notice in accordance with Article 16(2)(a), or
  - (c) acknowledgement in accordance with Article 16(4),
- whichever such date is the later.

The application and associated correspondence, including the acknowledgements and notifications referred to in Article 15, are available on the public file relating to the application as they arise and that file may be inspected by any person during office hours at the Agency's headquarters. Copy extracts from the file will be supplied by the Agency to any person, on request, subject to payment of the reasonable cost of making the copy. The Agency will have regard to any submission made in accordance with the Regulations and will write, in due course, to each person who makes such a submission, to advise them of the Agency's proposed decision on the application.



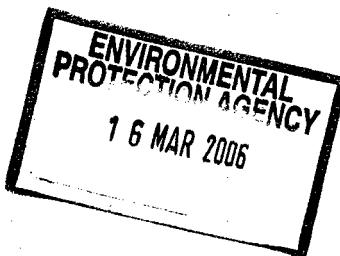
