re: Notice in accordance with Article 36 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, in respect of an application for a review of a waste licence by North Tipperary County Council for a facility at Ballaghveny Landfill, Ballymackey, County Tipperary.

Dear Sir/Madam

In accordance with Article 36 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations, the Agency hereby notifies you of its decision to grant a revised waste licence to North Tipperary County Council, subject to conditions, in respect of a facility at Ballaghveny Landfill, Ballymackey, County Tipperary. Please find accompanying a copy of the Agency's decision.

This decision was made following consideration of the objections and technical committee report to the Agency's proposed decision in accordance with the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005 and related Regulations. The objection, technical committee report and associated documents are available for inspection or purchase at the Agency's headquarters and at the offices of **North Tipperary County Council** in accordance with the Regulations.

Also enclosed is a copy of a draft Guidance Note on Environmental Management Systems and Reporting to the Agency. Conditions of the waste licence for the above facility require that the Agency is notified of specified matters and that reports and other materials are forwarded at defined intervals. The draft Guidance Note is intended to assist you in the production of this information. It is the Agency's intention to complete a review of this document in due course.

Please use the register number of the waste licence, W0078-02, in any future communication in respect of same and include an original and two copies of all items in the correspondence.
