re: Notice pursuant to Article 32 of the EPA (Licensing) Regulations, 2004, in respect of the proposed determination of the Agency on a review of an IPC licence application by Hegarty Metals Processors Limited Trading As Shannonside Galvanising, Reg. No. 745

Dear Mr. Hourigan

I refer to your objection to the Agency's proposed determination on the above referenced IPC licence review application, I am to advise that the Agency requests that you submit further information to enable the Agency to consider the objection.

You state in your objection that Shannon Galvanizing can have a throughput of approximately 140 tonnes of steel per week. This appears to indicate that your steel input to the galvanising plant is greater than 2 tonnes per hour.

In light of this possible change in processing capacity, specify whether the installation is a category of industrial activity referred to in Annex I of the IPPC Directive (96/61/EC) and if yes specify the category.

I am to request you to submit the specified information to the Agency no later than 5th July 2006.

In the circumstances, you should make immediate arrangements to have the required document(s) (1 signed original and 2 copies in hardcopy format, and 2 copies of all files in electronic searchable PDF format on CD-ROM) submitted to the Agency without delay.

Please note that the application's register number is 745. It is important that all correspondence in relation to this matter is directed to the *Licensing Unit, Office of Licensing & Guidance, Environmental Protection Agency, Headquarters, PO Box 3000, Johnstown Castle Estate, County Wexford* quoting the register number.

I am to advise that in default of compliance with the requirements of this notice, the Agency will, after 5th July 2006, and without further notice to you, make a decision in respect of the application.
