c.800 grams of a dense gelatinous liquid was received and examined. It was suspected that this material might be of plant origin however analysis for cellulose, lignin, pectin was negative. Analysis for the presence of lipid was also negative. The pH of this sample was 5.8 and microscopic examination revealed what appeared to be plankton cells in the liquid, the odour of this sample was reminiscent of 'peaty' river water. Based on the above analysis this sample does not appear to be harmful.
