Application to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Waste Licence

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the provisions of the Waste Management Acts 1996 to 2005 and Articles 5 and 6 of the Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. No. 395 of 2004) that Fingal County Council, County Hall, Swords, Fingal, Co. Dublin will apply to the Environmental Protection Agency for a Waste Licence for the proposed development of a landfill at Tooman / Nevitt, Lusk, Co. Dublin - National Grid erence: X317, 606, Y256, 905.

Éingal County Council proposes to develop the landfill for non-hazardous waste with an annual intake of up to 500, 000 tonnes per annum and also a public recycling facility. The proposed Fingal Landfill development will comprise a new fully engineered landfill. The landfill disposal area will incorporate approximately 57 hectares to be developed in discrete lined cells, over approximately eleven construction phases and to include the provision of leachate collection and treatment and gas collection and utilisation. A remaining area of approximately 153 hectares is to be used as a buffer area for screening / landscaping of the landfill. The waste disposal area will cater for up to 9,400,000 nes of waste over the lifetime of the fility.

The types of waste proposed to be received at the landfill for disposal include:

- Non-Hazardous Municipal Waste
- Industrial Non-Hazardous Waste
- Construction and Demolition Waste
- Biological sludge produced as a waste by-product of the on site leachate treatment system
- Residues from Water and Wastewater Treatment
- Non-Hazardous Bottom Ash from Waste to Energy Plants

The classes of activity concerned in accordance with the Third Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005 are as follows:

Class 4: Surface impoundment, including placement of liquid or sludge discards into pits, ponds or lagoons

Class 5 Specially engineered landfill, including placement into lined discrete cells which are capped and isolated from one another and the environment

Class 6: Biological treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 5 or paragraphs 7 to 10 of this Schedule

- Class 7: 6 Physico-chemical treatment not referred to elsewhere in this Schedule which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by means of any activity referred to in paragraphs 1 to 5 or paragraphs 8 to 10 of this
 - Schedule (including evaporation, drying and calcination).
- Class 11 Blending or mixture prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule


Class 13: Storage prior to submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where the waste concerned is produced. The classes of activity concerned in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts, 1996 to 2005 are as follows:

Class 3:	Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds
Class 4:	Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials
Class 9:	Use of any waste principally as a fuel or other means to generate energy
Class 11	Use of waste obtained from any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule
Class 13:	Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

The **Principal Activity** at the site is Class 5 of the Third Schedule as detailed above.

An Environmental Impact Statement (E.I.S.) will be submitted to the Agency with the application.

A copy of the Waste Licence Application, the Environmental Impact Statement (E.I.S.) and such further information relating to the application as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application will, as soon as is practicable after receipt by the Agency, be available for inspection or purchase, at the Headquarters of the Environmental. Protection Agency, Johnstown Castle, Estate, Wexford and at Fingal County Council Headquarters, County Hall, Swords, Fingal, Co. Dublin. It will also be available at the Council offices at Grove Road, Banchardstown, Fingal, Co. Dublin. and Balbriggan Town Council Offices, George's Square, Balbriggan, Fingal, Co. Dublin.
